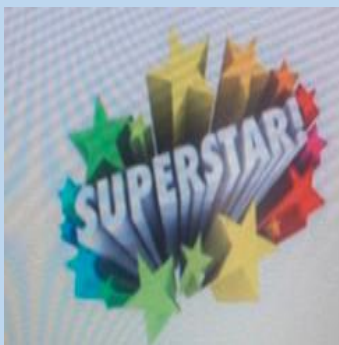
To our Valued Parents and Guardians

From the Head

I greet you all in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and express my heartfelt gratitude for your unwavering support throughout this term. Your dedication to our school functions, timely payments of school fees and overall involvement have been instrumental in ensuring the smooth operation of Quality Junior School.

2. Mid-Term Assessment Awards

In our commitment to encouraging academic excellence, we conducted mid-term assessments and presented awards to outstanding learners. This initiative aims to motivate our learners to strive for continuous improvement.



1. Sports

This term has been bustling with a variety of ball games, including soccer, netball, hockey, rugby, table tennis, and volleyball. We successfully introduced new disciplines such as hockey, table tennis, and rugby. Our friendly match with Greenland Springs Junior School showcased the exceptional performance of our teams. Additionally, we are proud to announce that the construction of our multipurpose court is now 50% complete, and plans to start constructing our swimming pool next term while we outsource swimming services for a very short period are underway.



3. Cultural Activities

Our cultural celebrations, including Earth Day, Africa Day, and the Arts Festival, were a resounding success. Furthermore, our learners excelled in debate, public speaking, and music, with notable achievements in various competitions and events.

A notable achievement was of the Mozambique trip to the PriDC 2024 SADC Competitions where Ashley Nyamande (Grade 7 Blue), who was doing public speaking, managed to reach the finals as she scooped the second position out of 62 participants. The other three, Allina Hloka (Grade 6 Red), Yeukai Zifamba (Grade 6 Blue) and Angello Mutaramuswa (Grade 6 Blue), managed to reach the quarter finals and they are through to the PriDC Pan African Competitions in Kenya scheduled in November 2024.



4. Third Term Enrolment

Limited places are available for QualiCreche'. ECDA, ECDB and Grade 1 up to Grade 5. Prospective 2025 pupils are encouraged to apply now. A comprehensive calendar of events for the third term will be issued at the beginning of term 3, including details about our upcoming long-distance educational trips.



6. Trips and Events

We organized enriching successful trips and educational tours, including a one-day trip for Infants to the Royal Finesse Virtual Reality at Westgate and an overnight winter camp for Juniors at Karumazondo in Marondera. Both trips were exciting for our learners and they thoroughly enjoyed. Looking ahead, we are planning long distance trips for the next term and for the international trip early next year.



5. School Renovations

Our school underwent significant renovations and upgrading that include:

- a) Painting of the school security wall and buildings (inside and outside),
- b) Ablution block renovations and upgrading,
- c) Tiling of the Grade 1 block,
- d) Paving of the school pathways,
- e) Introduction of the school tuckshop.

The aesthetic of our school was improved by these renovations and we are grateful for the commitment shown by our Board of Directors.
