#### From the Head

Welcome to Term 3 of 2024 and special а welcome our new to learners and parents / guardians who have joined us this term. We have interesting activities lined and up am confident that we are going to have an educational and captivating summer. From next week on Monday 16 September 2024 onwards, the school will start at 7:30am and end at 3.00pm for all Grades. Parents/Guardians are therefore reminded to come with children on time as well as pick up children from school before 3:30pm daily.

# 1. Uniforms

Pupils should now revert back to wearing the summer uniform and they are to be appropriately dressed at all times. Blazers are to be worn on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays by Grade 1 - 7 pupils. QualiCreche' and ECD pupils must wear their aprons everyday. Tuesdays and Thursdays are for tracksuits, golf shirts and white tackies. Please note that anorak jackets may be worn on cold days.

NB: 1. The main school uniform is **not** to be mixed with the sportswear.

2. All uniform items should be clearly labelled with the pupil's name including the shoes and satchels.

3. We now have sports bags and food bags at school for the Grade 1s up to Grade 7s. Our QualiCreche', ECD A and ECD B pupils will only get the food bags. Please make your purchases of the bags at the school offices.



#### 3. School Renovations and Projects

There are several significant renovations and upgrading of the school that happened and we are at advanced stages of completing our multipurpose court. Our swimming pool will be constructed at the end of Term 3, 2024 and in the meantime, we will continue with our usual swimming arrangements this term being Thursdays as our swimming day every week. Pupils should therefore have their swimming trunks/costumes, slippers, drying towels, Vaseline/lotion, white boxer shorts and golf shirts in their QJS sports bags (the sports bags are available for sale at school). Fees payments are payable either in full or can be paid in a maximum of 3 instalments stated in brackets above whose deadlines are as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> instalment (already

# past): by 7 September 2024, 2<sup>nd</sup> instalment: by 7 October 2024,

3<sup>rd</sup> & final instalment: by 7 November 2024.

Any divergence of payment plans should be put in writing and approved by the School Finance Committee. After the deadline and failure to fulfil the agreed plans, pupils will be denied entry into classes.

### 4. Teaching and Learning

The school puts great emphasis on homework. We opened school on 10 September 2024 and effectively homework started coming through from the day. Parents are urged to supervise their children's homework and sign before it is brought back to school the following day.

The Reading Programme for all grades continues this term and parents/guardians are requested to buy readers for their children in accordance with their grades as follows:

Grade One	Sunrise book one up to book 10
Grade Two	Sunrise book 11 up to book 20
Grade Three	Blue book 1 to 3
Grade Four	Red book 1 to 4
Grade Five-Seven	One library book/reader

**Reading Diaries:** Make sure children have reading diaries. Please sign the child's reading diary and collaborate with the teacher for improvement / progress.

**Stationery:** Ensure that your child has all the necessary stationery requisites as specified on the stationery requirements lists for each grade (class teachers may furnish you with the lists).

**Progress Report Book:** All progress report books must be signed and brought back to the school by 30 October 2024. Please contact the school if you need to purchase one or if you need any further clarifications.



# 5. Grade 7 ZIMSEC Examinations

The Grade 7 ZIMSEC Examinations is starting from **Monday 23 September** to **Monday 7 October 2024.** The Grade 7 pupils' school fees and levies should have been paid by the first day of school opening as per Grade 7 School Fees Policy letters shared on 30 July 2024 and 29 August 2024.



Our third term is usually popular with interesting national educational trips. The Infants (ECD A to Grade 2) will be going for a one-day trip and the Juniors (Grade 2 - 7) will go for a three-day trip. Trips payments will be advised soon, we are encouraging you to start planning and saving for them now.



# 8. Quality Senior School 2025 Enrolment

Quality Senior School is now open for 2025 enrolment offering day and boarding facilities for both boys and girls. Quality Senior School will be a separate stand-alone entity from Quality Junior School.





# 7. Enrolment

**2025 Grade 1 Assessment Day:** Our 2025 Grade 1 Assessment Day will be on Saturday 28 September at 0900 hours. All prospective Grade 1 pupils will be taking Basic Assessment Tests at school and the usual Assessment Fee of US\$10 will be charged. Those that succeed will be required to pay a Commitment Fee of US\$50 by 30 October 2024. The Commitment Fee will go towards the next year's school fees.




# 9. Protocol
